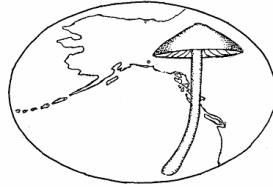


# Pacific Northwest Fungi



## News for January, 2007

Readers may notice several recent changes to *Pacific Northwest Fungi*.

The opening page now includes a Google-powered search function for searching the journal by key word. A suggested search strategy would be to use one or more key words to retrieve articles of interest, and then to use the search feature of Adobe Acrobat (or other pdf-reading software) to find instances where the key word is used within the article. We expect that readers will find this approach to be very effective for finding information in the journal.

Article format has been changed slightly. The font for articles has been changed and authors now have the option of including figures within the body of the text (as opposed to grouping figures at the ends of articles). In the near future we will be posting revised instructions to authors that will reflect such changes; in the meantime, prospective authors should contact the Editor-in-Chief with questions.

We also are pleased to note that abstracts for articles in *Pacific Northwest Fungi* will appear in *CAB Abstracts*.
