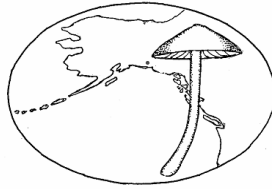


Pacific Northwest Fungi

Pacific Northwest Fungi is now accepting manuscripts that include proposals for nomenclatural novelties, including new species. In order to follow provisions of the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature for effective publication, printed copies of papers with taxonomic novelties will be published and distributed before being posted on the journal website. Authors will be required to register their proposed nomenclatural novelties with [MycoBank](#) and to refer to assigned MycoBank numbers in the article. The cost of publishing and mailing printed copies will be borne by the author; for details please contact the Editor-in-Chief. Authors can expect to benefit from rapid time to publication (typically a few days after acceptance of final copy for publication) and assurance that new taxa will be quickly added to [Index Fungorum](#), a major benefit of the MycoBank system.
